WHAT TO DO AFTER AN ACCIDENT

SAFETY

- Stay calm
- Turn on your indicator warning lights
- Only move your vehicle if it is safe to do so and there are no injuries.



INFORMATION

- Collect information, if possible.
- Third party name & surname
- Address & telephone number
- License & registration number
- Insurance & towing company

COMMON INJURIES

Whiplash, concussion, broken bones, contusions and abrasions or cuts.

Some injuries only become evident hours or days later.

MEDICAL HELP

- Check for injuries and call ER24 on 084 124.
- Tell the call taker what happened and how many people are injured.
 - Provide first aid, if possible.

IMPORTANT

- Provide exact location and landmark
 - Provide your telephone number
- State how many vehicles and type,
 i.e. truck, car, taxi, etc.
- State how many people are injured
 - State if anyone is trapped
 - State any dangers,
 - i.e. vehicle on fire or chemicals
